

# Health, Safety, Environment and Sustainability (HSES) Policy

This Policy is approved by the Telko Management Team on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2025. The Head of HSEQ is responsible for the evaluation of this Policy on an annual basis.

# **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this document is to harmonise and clarify Health, Safety and Environment matters within Telko Group and to ensure that we operate in a sustainable way and without causing harm to people or environment during the complete business chain.

### **SCOPE**

This policy applies to all Telko employees, encompassing all work-related tasks and operations. While Telko has obtained ISO 14001 certification for only select sites, we uphold the same principles across the entire company.

### **PRINCIPLES**

Telko's mission is to bridge Industrial customers and principals in a sustainable way. Telko aims to become a forerunner in sustainability in its industry. The basis for our operations lies in our values; we believe in success by people, partnership, responsibility and continuous development.

We apply our values both in our internal processes and to provide value to our customers. This is done by using industry-leading expertise, strong partnerships and renowned service capabilities to improve Telko's customers' production lead times, material efficiency, and financial and environmental performance.

#### **TARGETS**

Sustainability development is one of Telko's strategic targets. The sustainability work, including environmental, social and governance aspects, is based on our sustainability targets which are defined by Telko management team according to a materiality analysis and accepted by Telko Board. The main targets are implemented for our operations through sub targets, road maps and action plans and aim to have the sustainability KPIs in personal targets for all supervisors and widely to all employees. Development and results are regularly monitored by management and the targets are reviewed on a yearly basis.

This policy will be communicated through our intranet and external web pages. It will also be disseminated in relevant training sessions and meetings to all employees, customers, suppliers, and the public. All employees are expected to cooperate and assist in implementing this policy while ensuring their work is carried out without risk to themselves, others, or the environment.
